Position Purpose:

As a Camp Counselor at CampOUT, your primary responsibility is to create a safe, inclusive, and engaging environment for campers. You will facilitate and participate in various camp activities, mentor campers, and contribute to their personal growth and well-being.

Essential Job Functions:

• Supervision and Safety:

- Supervise and ensure the safety of campers during all activities and throughout their stay at camp.
- Enforce camp rules and policies to maintain a safe and respectful camp environment.
- Respond to and manage any camper concerns, conflicts, or incidents in a prompt and appropriate manner.

• Recreational Activities:

- Plan and lead age-appropriate recreational activities, games, and outings.
- Foster a positive and inclusive atmosphere where campers feel valued and supported.
- Provide guidance and mentorship to campers, promoting personal growth and social development.
- Teamwork and Communication:

Counselors may be asked to use fire protection equipment, specialty program equipment. Some may be asked to drive camp golf carts.

Qualifications: (Minimum Education and Experience)

- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Previous camp counselor experience or experience working with children and youth is a plus.
- Certification in First Aid and CPR preferred.
- Candidates must have the ability to pass a background screening, with the associated costs covered no sooner than 60 days prior to the commencement of the camp.
- Must submit a health history record by camp deadline

- Strong leadership and teamwork skills.
- Excellent problem-solving abilities.
- Adaptability and flexibility in a dynamic camp environment.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Physical requirements may include prolonged standing, walking, some bending, lifting (including the ability to lift up to 50 lbs), and outdoor activities.

- Willingness to live on-site and in the cabins with campers during camp sessions and work irregular hours.
